

WESSEX ARABIAN HORSE GROUP

The above classes may be divided or amalgamated according to entries.
Foals must be 30 days or over on the day of the Show and shown suitably haltered, without chains.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show is affiliated to The Arab Horse Society and will be subject to the current AHS Rules, copies of which are available from the AHS on 01672 520782.
2. The Wessex Committee does not accept liability for any accident, death, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators, or any other persons or property. Exhibitors must indemnify the Wessex Committee against all actions, costs, claims, demands or liability arising out of any action in which he or she may be concerned.
3. All exhibits must be registered by the closing date for entries in the appropriate stud book or register of the AHS and copy certificates (including ownership details on the reverse) are requested with all entry forms, with the exception of foals. Incomplete entries will be returned.
4. Entries should be accompanied by the appropriate fees and will not be acknowledged unless requested. Please enclose a SAE for return of numbers.
5. The Wessex Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, to amalgamate or further divide classes according to entries, and to arrange for replacement judges, if necessary.
6. Refund of entry fees will only be made on production of a vet's or doctor's certificate.
7. No substitution of entries will be permitted after the closing date for entries.
8. It is expected that competitors will behave in a polite and reasonable way to the show organisers and their staff. In the event of a serious failure to do so, the Wessex Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to future shows for anyone failing to comply.
9. In accordance with AHS Rule 23, objections under AHS Rules must be made in writing and submitted to the Show Secretaries by AHS Members only, within two hours of the end of the class or the occurrence to which exception has been taken. Objections must be accompanied by a deposit of £50.00 (cheques made payable to the AHS) which will be forfeited if the objection is deemed to be frivolous or vexatious. The decision of the Wessex Committee is final.
10. All cups and trophies are perpetual and should be returned to the Show Secretaries by the closing date for entries. The Wessex Committee reserves the right to replace or reallocate any cup or trophy which becomes unsuitable for presentation.
11. Unruly horses may be asked to leave the ring. Any exhibitor whose horse breaks free in the show ring will be fined £15.00. No fine will be imposed if this is caused by a loose horse.
12. No horse or rider may enter the ring late, or leave the ring during a class, without obtaining permission from the judge through the ring steward.
13. The times given in the schedule are approximate but classes will not start before the stated time. Classes will follow on after the times indicated in the schedule.
14. Mounting blocks may be used by the Judge in ridden classes. Exhibits should be prepared for this eventuality.
15. Ridden horses may warm up on the Outdoor School. In the interests of safety, please be sure to pass **left shoulder to left shoulder** and keep to the inside track when walking. Please note that **no lunging is allowed**.
16. There are first aiders on site and a vet on call; please ask the Show Secretaries. Exhibitors using the services of the vet are responsible for paying all charges.
17. Dogs on the showground must be kept on a lead and should not be left in cars in hot weather.
18. Parking is limited so please park as directed by the attendant, and take your rubbish and manure home.
19. Any incident of neglect or ill treatment of any horse should be reported immediately to the Show Secretaries.
20. Exhibitors are reminded not to leave vehicles unlocked or valuable equipment unattended.
21. The judgement of the Wessex Committee shall be final in the interpretation of these rules and regulations.
