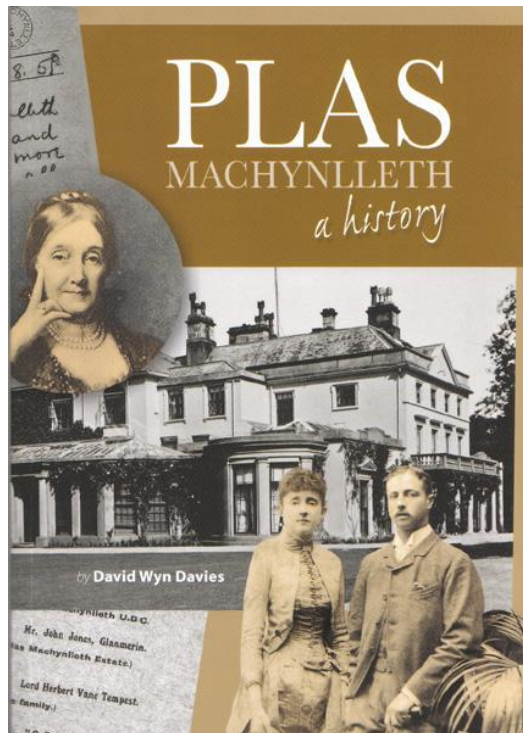


Plas Machynlleth - A History



Prolific Machynlleth historian and author David Wyn Davies has now published a short history of Plas Machynlleth which takes the reader from the early development of the estate through to its heyday as the Welsh home of the Vane-Tempests and the Marquesses of Londonderry. The story continues through subsequent years and finally takes us right up to its reclamation by Machynlleth Town Council in 2008 and the successful development of the Plas as a town asset.

Full use is made of unique photographs and press reports from the time of King George V's famous visit in 1911, thanks to the generous access to family scrapbooks given to the author by Mrs. Audrey Beaumont.
